NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Notification No. F.5/4/65-GP, dated the 11th January 1965 of the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, and in supersession of (i) the Planning and Development Department's Notification No. 29622/65-Sectt., dated the 28th October 1966, (ii) the Finance Department's Notifications n G.O. No. 372/Press, dated the 24th December 1968, (iii) in G.O. No. 373/Press, dated 24th December 1968 and (iv) in G.O. No. 374/Press, dated the 24th December 1968, the Lieutenant-Governor, Pondicherry hereby nakes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'B' (Non-Gazetted) Technical posts in the Department of Economics and Statistics, Pondicherry, namely:—

- 1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Pondicherry, Department of Economics and Statistics, Group 'B' (Non-Gazetted) Technical posts Recruitment Rules, 2005.
 - (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official gazette.
- 2. Application.—These rules shall apply for recruitment to the posts as specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed hereto.
- 3. Number of posts, its classification and scale of pay.—The number of the said posts, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.
- 4. Methods of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.—The method's of recruitment of the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in olumns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.
 - 5. Disqualification. No person, -
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person hall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the ersonal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds foo doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 6. Power to relax.—Where the Lieutenant-Governor, is of the opinion, that it is necessary or expedien to do, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rule ith respect to any class or category of persons.
 - 7. Savings .- Nothing in these rules shall affect-
- (a) The reservations, relaxations in upper age limit and other concessions required to be provided the scheduled castes, the scheduled tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard; and
 - (b) The appointment and promotions already made in accordance with the rules hereby superseded

7. Age limit for direct recruits

 Not exceeding 30 years. (Relaxable for Government servants up to five years in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Government).

The crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India (and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahoul and Spiti Districts and Pangi Subdivision of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep).

 Educational and other qualifications required for: direct recruits. Essential:

Post-graduate Degree in Statistics/Mathematics/ >Economics from a recognised university or equivalent.

2. Two years experience in the relevant field.

Note 1: Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the S.S.C. in case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note 2: The qualification(s) regarding experience is/ are relaxable at the discretion of the S.S.C. in case of candidates belonging to scheduled castés or scheduled tribes, if at any stage of selection the S.S.C. is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the posts reserved for them.

 Whether age and educational qualifications: prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees.

10. Period of probation, if any

2 years for direct recruits and promotees.

- 11. Method of recruitment whether by direct: Promotion failing which by deputation failing be recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/ direct recruitment. absorption and percentage of the posts to be filled by various methods.
- 12. In case of recruitment by promotion /deputation/ : absorption, grades from which promotion/ deputation/absorption is to be made.

Statistical Inspectors with three years regular s in the grade.

Note: Where juniors who have completed qualifying/eligibility service are being consider promotion, their seniors would also be considered pr they are not short of the requisite qualifying/elig service by more than half of such qualifying/elig service, or two years, whichever is less, and successfully completed their probation period for proto the next higher grade along with their juniors wh already completed such qualifying/eligibility serv

Deputation:

Officers of the Central/State Governments Territories-

- (a) (i) Holding analogous posts on regular ba the parent cadre/department; or
 - (ii) With three years service in the grade re after appointment thereto on regular b the scale of pay of Rs. 5,000-8,000 or equ in the parent cadre/department; and
- (b) Possessing the educational qualification experience prescribed for direct recruits column 8.

(The departmental officers in the feeder category in the direct line of promotion will not be elig consideration for appointment on deputation. Si deputationists shall not be eligible for considera appointment by promotion. Period of deputation in the period of deputation in another ex-cadre po immediately preceding this appointment in the s some other organisation/department of the Government shall ordinarily not exceed three yes maximum age limit for appointment by deputation be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of of applications).
