Subject: payment of wages to outsources persons of Ministries/Department and other organizations of Government of India during 2nd Wave of COVID-19 - reg.

Attention is invited to this Department's OM of even No. dated 23.03.2020 and persons outsources payment of wages regarding Ministries/Department and other organizations of Government of India during lockdown period due to COVID-19.

- It has been seen that the 2nd wave of COVID-19, starting mid April and 2. continuing till now has impacted a large number of people in the country. However, unlike a nationwide lockdown last year, lockdown during this year has varied throughout the country based on the severity of the 2nd wave. Due to this there is a likelihood of number of contractual, casual and outsources staff such as house-keeping staff etc. being required to stay at home for various reasons, which under normal circumstances, would result in deduction in their pay/wages. In order to avoid any undue hardships under the prevailing extraordinary circumstances, it has been decided outsourced casual and any such contractual, wherever Ministries/Departments and other organizations of Government of India, is required to stay at home due to state wise lockdown imposed by States/UT Governments or otherwise as deem fit by the competent authority, they may be treated as "on duty" during such period of absences and necessary pay/wages would be paid accordingly.
- These instructions shall apply for the period 1^{st} April, $2021 30^{th}$ June, 2021. 3.
- These instructions shall also apply to Attached/Subordinate Offices. 4. Autonomous/Statutory Bodies of Government of India.
